SCENE 8

THE KLEIN HOME IN BROOKLYN.

GENIE

GENIE kisses her and takes the baby.

GERRY

Hold on.

HE kisses the baby.

Night, little sweetheart.

GENIE

You'll notice she's stopped crying. Is all I'm saying.
